REGISTRATION: All animals are registered with their respective breed organizations and certificates of registration will be transferred to the new owner free of charge.

GUARANTEE: Each animal is guaranteed as represented. All announcements from the pedigree man take precedence over any printed information in the catalog. The purchaser shall notify the breed secretary, co-op president and breeder within 30 days after the sale if any gilt proves not to be with pig. The following guarantee implies at this auction: gilts are expected to be bred to a designated boar on date of service. If proven otherwise – (1) the gilt will be replaced with another that is satisfactory to the buyer, (2) the difference will be refunded between the purchase price and market value of the sow as shown by a sales receipt if the gilt is sold at market, (3) if the buyer desires to keep the gilt, 50% of the difference between purchase price and market value of the gilt at the time of purchase will be refunded. Failure by the purchaser to make notification cancels the guarantee.

HEALTH: All hogs originate from a validated free herd of Brucellosis and Pseudorabies or will be bled negative for both within 30 days of the show. Out of state buyers should check with their veterinarian concerning your state health regulations and requirements. If you are required to have an entry permit number, please bring it to the auction.

OWNERSHIP: The ownership of the animal changes hands when sold.

UPDATES: Catalog updates, additions and corrections available at ringside.

SETTLEMENT: Cash/check/credit card. 3% credit card service fee. **All buyers planning to pay by check who are 1st time attendees or unknown to auctioneer, auction staff or consignors must present a current bank letter of guaranteed funds addressed to Harry H. Bachman Auctioneer before purchasing any animals** If you don't provide a bank letter of credit you won't be given a bidder's number. All fees pertaining to collection of unpaid accounts or checks issued with non-sufficient funds will be paid by the buyer. No animals to be removed from Farm Show Complex before full settlement has been made with the auction cashiers. If you have an agent purchasing any bred gilts for you in your absence, they are responsible for the payment of your purchases before bred gilts can leave the barn. Animals can be removed as soon as they have been settled for and the release slip is presented to the swine committee load out staff.

All bred gilts must be removed from the barn by 5:00 p.m. auction day.

IMPORTANT NOTE – OUT OF STATE BUYERS: If your state requires a health permit number, you must present this to the auction veterinarians in order for them to write interstate health charts – no exceptions. All out of state buyers should know the entry requirements into their state.
